## 5th Cross-border Skirogaining February 28 – March 1 2015 Klíny in Ore Mountains









**The 5<sup>th</sup> Cross-border Skirogaining** will be organized at the weekend on February 28 – March 1 2015 as a two-stage event (3 hour training on Saturday and 6 hour race on Sunday). The event centre will be located in Klíny in Ore Mountains. The race is suitable both for recreational sportsmen and for elite athletes, as the number and order of the visited control points is up to each team (go-as-you-please).

In case of bad snow conditions the Sunday event will be held as 5 hour foot orienteering competition.

Each team consists of 2-5 members. Detailed map showing all event check points and all ski-tracks will be handed out at the registration desk. 30 minutes before start of the race you will receive map with point values of all controls and you can plan whether you enjoy ski-tracks treated with a snow cat (suitable for both classical style and skating, marked in the map with thick orange line),





dual tracks prepared for classical style only (thick dashed orange line),





or tracks made by tourists (thin dashed orange line),





or alternatively use tracks trodden by organizer only (orange dots in the map).
